COMPETITION RULES

The 28 Day See-a-Stride Challenge competition starts on **Monday, April 1st, 2024** and ends on **Sunday, April 28, 2024**. By signing up to the Challenge you automatically have one entry into the competition in which you do not have to participate. To be eligible to enter the competition, you **MUST** send in your 'Before' video no later than midnight in your time zone, **Sunday, April 7th, 2024**.

Before Video

Video yourself cantering over one fence with at least a 50 metre approach (either straight or off a turn). We need a clear side view of the last few strides and jumping the fence. Ensure you are in the centre of the video and not too far away. (See the video example).

All videos should be filmed in landscape mode and be no longer than 20 seconds.

Before midnight in your timezone on **Sunday, April 7th, 2024**, upload your video to www.thelucindagreenacademy.com/entry-2024 Attach your full name, your horse's name and the email you used when signing up to the challenge.

Make sure you upload high-quality videos. The higher the quality the easier it is for you to be judged fairly.

Ensure we can see at least 50 metres of the approach to the fence along with the take off and landing.

Once you have uploaded your video, you will receive an automatic response on the webpage, thanking you for uploading your entry (see the example below). If you do not receive this response on your screen, please upload your video again. Please do not email to check if your video has been uploaded as you will not receive a response.

After Video

Ditto the 'Before' video.

Video yourself cantering over one fence with at least a 50 metre approach (either straight or off a turn) . We need a clear side view of the last few strides and jumping the fence. Ensure you are in the centre of the video and not too far away. (See the video example).

Attach your full name, your horse's name and the email you used when signing up to the challenge.

Reigning World Champion, National Young Rider Champion, and individual Pony European Champion. Yasmin was runner up to Michael Jung at the Kentucky 5* and is still at the beginning of her career.



Boyd Martin

Boyd Martin, 2 x 5* winner, 2 x Pan Am Gold medalist, 3 x Olympian. Boyd is one of the best US event riders of all time.



William Fox-Pitt MBE

Olympic, World and European medalist, and winner of 14 grand slam titles including Badminton 2 times and Burghley a record 6 times.



Pippa Funnell

First person to win the Rolex Grand Slam, 2 times Badminton winner, 2 times European gold medalist and Olympic medalist. Pippa has been at the top of the sport for the last 4 decades.



Tom Crisp

Young Rider European Medalist and top 20 finishes at Burghley Horse Trials. Tom came to the public eye after showing great sportsmanship when he fell at the Badminton Lake this year and pretending to front crawl in the water, earning the name "Aqua Man"

Ex International 5* Event Rider, U18 coach, Pony Club and Riding club trainer for the last 3 decades. Mark understands grassroots riders and the struggles they face.



Diana Burgess
